

Creation Adventure and Field Trip – February 15, 2014

1. From Whitesburg Baptist Church parking lot, we will drive to Memorial Parkway, then driving north to exit onto I-565 East. From there we will drive to near Scottsboro.
2. Near Scottsboro, turn right on Highway 35.
3. Stay on Highway 35 and drive to Ft. Payne on 35. (In Ft. Payne, watch for a right turn on Highway 35.)
4. Continue driving on Highway 35 which takes us up Lookout Mountain.
5. When topping Lookout Mountain, take a left on County Road 89 at flashing light. There are signs there indicating DeSoto State Park is about 6 miles ahead on County Road 89.
6. We will stop in DeSoto State Park at the picnic area on the right. The Store and Information Station is on the left side of CR 89 across the street from the picnic area. There we will find restrooms, cold drinks, and foodstuffs, if needed. There is an honor box that the State has at the entrance to the picnic area asking for \$1.00 per person driving in. For safety's sake, we can drive on in and walk back later to feed the honor box. After we eat, we can convene in the parking lot to discuss our next stop.
7. Distance to DeSoto State Park (1-800-ALAPARK) is about 70 miles.

While the caravan of cars is moving, please use headlights. The lead and last cars will be in contact via radio transmitters.
